The app is designed to have four main modules:

1. Storing of health data

(i.e. tracking of medical events, symptoms& medications) to be used in consultationswith physicians and across borders.

2. Telehealth

to allow long-distance communication between users and healthcare professionals.



3. **Personalised resource library** that suggests validated resources to users (i.e. news, podcasts, videos, guidelines) based on their preferences and behaviour.



interaction to share experiences and find support.

The **smartCARE** project focuses on survivors, patients and caregivers through factfinding workshops and the input of the European Cancer Organisation's Patient Advisory Committee.
